The Potter's House Volleyball Tournament Rules

- 1. Volleyball Tournament will be held on September 12 & 13, 2020
- 2. The final four (4) teams will play the final championship games on Sunday September 13
- 3. Awards will be received on Sunday September 13 at the conclusion of the 6:00 pm Potter's House church service. Entire winning teams must be present in Church service to collect prizes or winnings will be forfeited.
- 4. Volley ball teams will consist of 5 players alternate/ substitute players will be permitted.
- 5. Each game will start with a coin toss. (Winner decides side or first to serve)
- 6. Person serving the ball will be serving behind the back line of the court and may hit the ball in any manner with the hand no throwing.
- 7. Serving team will continue to serve if a point is successfully scored after each volley.
- 8. Point will be played again if the ball hits the net and goes over on a serve.
- 9. Ball may be played off the net once the serve is good and the ball has come into play.
- 10. Ball may not be spiked on a serve.
- 11. Maximum of 3 hits per side before the ball must go over the net to continue being played.
- 12. Excess amount of hits will forfeit the ball to the opposing team along with a point gain to the receiving team.
- 13. Player may not hit the ball twice in succession but may hit the ball if a teammate plays it in between or if the opposing team returns the ball.
- 14. If the ball touches a player or player touches a ball during the volley, ball will be considered as being played.
- 15. No intentional kicking, kneeing, or using your head to hit the ball will be allowed.
- 16. No lifting or throwing the ball while it is in play.
- 17. Ball must be distinctively hit.
- 18. Points will be made on every serve for the winning team. (Rally scoring)
- 19. Games will be played up to 15 points and the winner must win by 2 points.
- 20. At no time during the game will any player be allowed to touch the net or cross sides.
- 21. If during the game one of the players touches the net or crosses the line (volleyball net), the ball will be forfeited to the other team along with a 1-point increase.
- 22. A ball landing on a boundary line is in.
- 23. Teams must rotate clockwise when receiving the ball to serve.
- 24. All players must be on the court and in place when the ball is served.
- 25. When two opponents simultaneously hit the ball out of bounds or touch the net at the same time, the point is played over. (Re-serve)
- 26. A ball may be blocked at the net (across the court) but hands may not reach over the net to block.
- 27. You may spike the ball but may not touch the net in doing so.
- 28. No unsportsmanlike conduct to include but not limited to: vulgarity, disrespect to officials, players or audience members will be tolerated.
- 29. No attempt to influence or question officials about decisions on plays will be allowed.
- 30. Lead official will be Matthew McCarthy.
